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CRITIQUING SELECTED RESPONSE ASSESSMENTS

Critiquing Question Stems

1. **Yes No** The stem is a self-contained question.
2. **Yes No** When the stem is not self-contained, the omitted portion of the question is located at the end.
3. **Yes No** The stem avoids the use of negatives. (no, none, not, etc)
4. **Yes No** Unintended clues are avoided in the question stem. (i.e. grammatical clues).
5. **Yes No** Personal opinions are not requested.
6. **Yes No** All vocabulary is age-appropriate.
7. **Yes No** Directions for the students are clear.

Critiquing Answer Choices

1. **Yes No** Answer choices are simply stated.
2. **Yes No** *All* distractors are plausible.
3. **Yes No** Answer choices are grammatically correct and aligned to the stem.
4. **Yes No** Answer choices are similar in length. When not possible, the choices are paired with two longer and two shorter choices.
5. **Yes No** “All of the above” and “None of the above” are avoided.
6. **Yes No** Numerical answers are written from smallest to largest.
7. **Yes No** Correct responses randomly occur in all positions.
