## Standards Based IEP

## Definition

A standards-based Individualized Education Program (IEP) describes a process in which the IEP team has incorporated state content standards in its development.

## Steps in the process



Step 1: Know and understand state standards.
Missouri Learning Standards (MLS), DESE Resources, MAPA

Step 2: Link district curriculum with state's learning standards. Gradelevel content and intent of content standards relative to your district




Step 7: Assess and report progress throughout the year. The 'bigger picture' for a student as they move through the education program

**Get to know and understand the student.** Strengths, needs, and visions for the student's future



Step 3: Determine student functioning in relation to Grade-Level Standards. Educational goals, curriculum, instruction, and assessment are consistent
