What is a Learning Lab?



Guided Peer Observation

Mini Professional Development of a topic that would benefit our teachers and also align to our building and district goals

Teachers learning from other teachers

Teacher to teacher feedback

Time to learn and plan in order to implement or improve a practice in their own classroom



Why did we implement Learning Labs?

Effective peer observations
Build in mini PD opportunities
Implement teacher to teacher feedback





How?

Big Picture and Goals:

Plan **two OR three** 2 hour sessions on one day with a specified focus area.

4-5 Teachers included in the learning lab Admin/Instructional Coach Participation



Steps:

- 1. 20 minute workshop style presentation. This is why we we are here, this is what we will be learning about, look for these things.
- 2. 3-10 minute observation experiences in three different areas (we started with 2 observations but feedback from teachers is that they wanted more time in the classrooms)
- 3. 10 minute Q & A with area/content expert
- 4. Group discussion and "aha's" on observations
- 5. Debrief Activity/Planning/Closing Session
- 6. Peer Observation Form Completed

Things to Think About

- Topic to present
 - Survey staff for needs
 - Feedback after presenting
- Schedule of the day
 - Admin finds <u>sub coverage</u>
 - Coaches run the day
 - Coach take the place of the teacher for Q&A
- How will we Debrief?
 - Debrief tool
 - Next level coaching
 - Set a goal for themselves

- Who will present?
 - Teachers
 - Instructional coach

- Who will we observe?
 - Volunteers
 - Coach finds
- What resources need to be gathered for planning?




